- ◆ take time out at the Barbican Centre

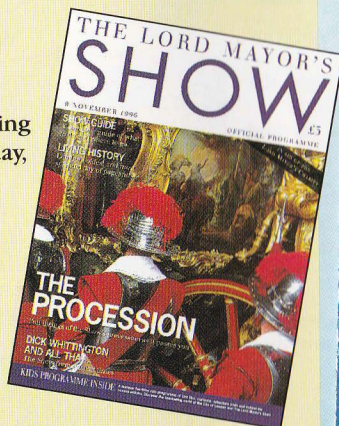


All these attractions and lots more are open on Lord Mayor's Show Day, and all are a stroll away from the processional route.
